From your friend in the mailbox - please read together.



A really important note for Friend -

Hi Friend! It's me, Zip. I have to tell you something really important.

NEVER check the mailbox without a grown-up with you. Please always go together - every single time.

Mailboxes are out near the street where cars drive, and Zip would feel SO sad if anything happened to you. Plus, the BEST part is reading the letter together with your grown-up!

For the grown-ups -

Zip's Mailbox Club takes safety seriously. Please review these reminders with every shipment:

- Inspect every item in the envelope BEFORE handing it to your child. Although we follow strict no-small-parts guidelines for kids under age 7, we strongly recommend a quick inspection on arrival - stickers, paper craft pieces, and decorative elements can pose choking risks for very young children, especially in households with younger siblings.
- Supervise every mailbox trip. Mailboxes are typically near roads. Your child should never approach or open the mailbox alone, even in low-traffic neighborhoods. Make it part of your shared ritual.
- Watch younger siblings closely if you read the letter as a family. Some pieces (real stamps, postcards, character cards) are sized appropriately for the addressed child but may not be safe for an under-3 sibling to handle.
- Email us anytime at zip@zipsmailboxclub.com if you find anything that concerns you, or if a piece arrived damaged. We replace it and update our supply checks immediately.
- Photos & sharing: only post or share what you're comfortable with. We never tag or identify your child without your explicit permission.
